PENSACOLA, Fla. – On Friday, Jan. 24, at 1 p.m., Rear Adm. Don Quinn will be relieved by Rear Adm. Mike White as Commander of the Naval Education and Training Command.

The ceremony will be held at the National Museum of Naval Aviation on board Naval Air Station Pensacola. The Chief of Naval Personnel, Vice Adm. Bill Moran, will be the guest speaker.

Media representatives are encouraged to cover the ceremony; a media availability will immediately following the change of command ceremony. Quinn will also be retiring from the Navy at the ceremony, the capstone of a 35-year career.
