TSC San Diego Recognized for Continued Training Excellence

SAN DIEGO — Training Support Center San Diego (TSCSD) staff members were recognized with a 2014 Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) Training Support Excellence Award (TEA) for the sixth consecutive year during a ceremony Feb. 5.

TSCSD received recognition for its exemplary training support of 23 independent Navy learning sites within the San Diego region. The command supports Navy and Marine Corps service members in surface, subsurface, and aviation schools, averaging a throughput of 72,000 students per year.

Also noted at the ceremony, TSCSD earned Functional Merit Awards for total-force management, logistics management, training support management, and financial management.

Capt. Robert E. Beauchamp, commanding officer of TSCSD said the awards are due to the outstanding dedication of his workforce.
