

EOD JUNIOR OFFICER COURSE (JOC)

COURSE DESCRIPTION: The EOD Junior Officer Course of Instruction is designed to provide initial pipeline training for officers assigned to Explosive Ordnance Disposal (EOD). This course trains junior officers in EOD group, mobile unit, and detachment/small unit organization to include organizational relationships with detachments/small units, small group dynamics, CPO/OIC relationships, ethics, and EOD case studies. This course places special emphasis on preparing officer candidates for the rigors of diver and explosive ordnance disposal training through intense physical fitness and aquatic adaptability preparation.

PREREQUISITES:

Candidate must be a commissioned officer. Candidate must be physically qualified and meet all requirements IAW MILPERSMAN 1220-200 and exhibits. Candidate must complete a diver physical IAW the Manual of the Medical Department (NAVMED P-117) Chapter 15-102, Change 126. Candidate must conform to Navy Physical Standards IAW OPNAVINST 6110.1 (Series).
