

Directions to Naval Support Activity, Panama City (NSA-PC)

[THE BASE WHERE THE AIR FORCE COMBAT DIVE COURSE (AFCDC) IS LOCATED]

- Upon arrival at Panama City / Bay County Airport, take a taxi to Naval Support Activity, "the Navy Base".
- Claim the taxi fare in your travel voucher upon completion of this TDY.
- Once at NSA-PC, proceed to the "Sea Shore Inn" (850-236-2500) Check into your room and prepare for training.
- NPS airmen must get orders stamped at the Quarterdeck (CQ) prior to being issued a room. After 2200 proceed to third deck CQ located in billeting then proceed to get the stamp and for linen issue.
- **Sunday Before First Training Day (Open Circuit Course):** On the Sunday before Day 1 of training, report to the Naval Diving and Salvage Training Center (NDSTC) in ABUs **at 1700hrs**. Report with the following in a backpack: orders, medical and dental records, proof of pressure test, travel itineraries, pen/paper. You will then in-process with the MTL's and receive Day 1 of Training instructions. **Also, items needed for Day 1 of Training are as follows: one gallon water bottle, USAF PT Gear (2x tan shirts, 2x blue or black shorts, 2x pairs socks, running shoes and towel. If needed: gray "Air Force" sweats, black watch cap, black gloves).**
- The PT test will be administered immediately on Day 1 of Training, followed by breakfast.
- Full POV info, building number, room number and room phone number (if apply) are needed for in-process.
- **Students only attending closed circuit (MK25) course:** Contact the course lead at 850-636-6248 or DSN 436-6248 prior to arranging travel to confirm course start date and time.
