1.0	.01	Upon completion of this unit of instruction, the student will define the requirements for Rescue Swimmer School training, Drop on Request and Training Time Out policies, and safety procedures used during Surface Rescue Swimmer training.
2.0	.29	Upon completion of this unit of instruction, the student will achieve and maintain a level of physical conditioning and proficiency that will enable satisfactory performance of rescue swimmer duties in a swimming pool or open ocean, while wearing appropriate Rescue Swimmer equipment as outlined in NTTP 3-50.1 and OPNAVINST 3130.6 series, without injury to personnel or damage to equipment.
3.0	.55	Upon completion of this unit of instruction, the student will demonstrate proper rescue techniques of military and civilian personnel, day or night, utilizing appropriate SAR equipment for at-sea rescues as outlined in NTTP 3-50.1 and OPNAVINST 3130.6 series, without injury to personnel or damage to equipment.
4.0	.15	Upon completion of this unit of instruction, the student will identify and treat medical emergencies using approved SAR medical equipment, as per NAVEDTRA 14295 and NTTP 3-50.1 manuals, without injury to personnel or damage to equipment.

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
