The completed pre-screening certification sheet must accompany the trainee and be presented with orders on the first day of convening; trainees without pre-screening certification sheets will be refused training and sent back to their parent command.

f. Trainees must be physically fit and must have passed the last Physical Fitness Assessment (PFA) in accordance with OPNAVINST 6110.1H.

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g. Trainees must not be in a Light or Limited Duty (LIMDU) status. Trainees cannot be pregnant. No recent recoveries from injuries that preclude riding small boats, performing tactics, or cycling weapons.

h. Bee sting and shellfish reaction kits are required for those allergic, provided by trainee.

3. This course has been designated High-Risk in accordance with NETCINST 5100.1A. It is highly recommended that trainees be in a non-duty status while enrolled in the course.
