1. Purpose. To establish Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) policy for use of the NETC-Front End Analysis (NETC-FEA) process per references (a) through (d). All personnel shall use reference (e) when conducting a NETC-FEA.

2. Cancellation. NETCINST 1500.6.

3. Scope. NAVEDTRA 138 provides NETC Learning Centers with guidance in conducting a NETC-FEA to provide accurate and complete data for a comprehensive Business Case Analysis (BCA).

4. Background. The Department of the Navy (DON) performs FEA as delineated in reference (f) during the development of a Navy Training System Plan (NTSP) to satisfy Navy/Marine Corps Acquisition Category (ACAT) programs. These FEAs do not fully address all training requirements the NETC domain is responsible for providing to the Fleet and does not address training requirements to support the delivery of occupational standards. Therefore, NETC developed a standardized FEA process to determine content media types and media delivery mode recommendations.
