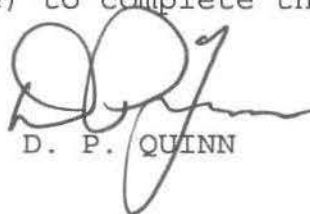

1. Purpose. The purpose of the Naval Education and Training Command (NETC) Job Duty Task Analysis (JDTA) process is to establish a repeatable and defensible job analysis process to develop or revise training content. The goal of this process is to provide a single standard for capturing all JDTA data which is aligned to a job. This will allow a single transition strategy to be developed to support all occupations and provide clear guidance to assist NETC domain commands/Learning Centers (LCs) in developing training to an approved standard.
2. Cancellation. NETCINST 1510.4.
3. Scope. The goal of the JDTA process is to provide a single uniform forum for decomposing and structuring work, and to assign attributes to that work.
4. Background. NETC has implemented the JDTA as the first step in building training content.
5. Policy. All NETC commands/LCs shall refer to references (a) through (d) and use reference (e) to complete the JDTA process.
