1. Purpose. To establish the fiscal year 2026 High-Risk Training (HRT) Safety (HRTS) Evaluation (HRTSE), Moderate-Risk Course Evaluation (MRCE), Mobile Training Team (MTT) evaluations, and Safety and Occupational Health (SOH) Management Evaluation (SOHME) schedules for Naval Education and Training Command (NETC).

2. Background

a. Reference (a) requires NETC to establish a HRTS oversight program to ensure subordinate activities comply with HRTS requirements. This requires triennial on-site HRTSEs at each HRT activity. Reference (b) requires headquarters commands to establish and maintain a comprehensive Safety Management System (SMS) and provide oversight to subordinate activities. This requires either virtual or on-site SOHMEs be conducted at subordinate commands, units, and activities at a minimum of every 48 months. Reference (c) requires NETC to conduct a triennial MRCE on designated courses as part of the HRTS program and evaluate HRT MTTs.

b. References (c) and (d) define requirements, responsibilities, and processes for conducting these evaluations.

3. Action

a. NETC N00X must:

(1) Conduct triennial on-site HRTSEs of all traditional and non-traditional (contracted) HRT courses as scheduled in enclosure (1). HRTSEs may be conducted more often, as determined by NETC N00X. The HRTSE will include HRT conducted at commercial, foreign, and training sites owned by activities outside of the NETC domain but used by NETC training commands.

(2) Conduct triennial on-site MRCEs of all traditional and non-traditional (contracted) courses as scheduled in enclosure (1).

(3) Conduct on-site HRT MTT evaluations as scheduled in enclosure (1) and when requested by learning centers (LC).

(4) Conduct quadrennial SOHMEs of commands as scheduled in enclosure (2). If necessary, SOHMEs of commands who have more complex SOH programs may be conducted triennially, as determined by NETC N00X. SOHMEs will be conducted on-site or in a virtual format. The SOHME will include a review of safety elements associated with the command's SMS, risk management information (RMI) database implementation and management, base operating support safety services, and all applicable SOH programs per references (b) and (d).

(5) Send an e-mail announcement to the appropriate LC or immediate superior in command (ISIC), with a copy to the activity being evaluated, no later than 30 days prior to the confirmed date of evaluations (HRTSE, MRCE, or SOHME). Additionally, NETC N00X will coordinate with the activity to ensure training is being conducted as much as possible during the week of the HRTSE or MRCE.

(6) Upon completion of the HRTSE, MRCE, or SOHME, NETC N00X will out-brief any findings with the command and send a written report of the findings within 30 days of completion of

the evaluation. Any discrepancies identified during the evaluation will be recorded and managed through the RMI database.

b. Naval Service Training Command and Navy Recruiting Command must:

(1) Conduct SOHMEs, per references (b) and (d), of all subordinate activities in order to assess the effectiveness of their SMS and SOH Program at a minimum of every 48 months.

(2) Promulgate a SOHME schedule to be released no later than 1 October of each year, with a copy to NETC N00X.

(3) Notify activities scheduled for a SOHME at least 30 days prior to commencement of the evaluation.

(4) Provide an advanced copy of the measurement criteria to the commanding officer (CO) via electronic means, allowing sufficient time for them to gather necessary documentation.

(5) Provide formal report of findings to the ISIC CO, with a copy to NETC N00X, following completion of the SOHME. Any discrepancies identified during the SOHME will be recorded and managed through the RMI database.
