1. <u>Purpose</u>. To provide a consolidated listing of requirements and entitlements at postsecondary schools participating in the NROTC Preparatory Program (NPP). The NPP is administered and funded by the host postsecondary school. This notice serves only to consolidate these schools' requirements and entitlements as best understood by Naval Service Training Command as of its effective date.

2. <u>Background</u>. Every year, a letter from Commander, Naval Service Training Command is distributed to participating NPP universities listing scholarship reservations. The letter does not include any information on specific NPP participating postsecondary school requirements or entitlements provided by those schools to NPP participant students.

3. <u>Applicability</u>. This notice provides consolidated information as of its effective date. It is not meant to be an exclusive reference and will be updated annually.

Per NSTCINST 1533.3A:

Tier 1 majors are engineering programs of Navy interest, such as: aerospace/aeronautical/astronautic engineering, chemical engineering, electrical engineering, mechanical engineering, naval architecture/marine engineering, nuclear engineering, ocean engineering, systems engineering.

Tier 2 majors are other engineering, math, and science programs such as: agricultural/biological engineering, astrophysics, biochemistry, biophysics/molecular biology, biomathematics/bioinformatics, biomedical engineering, cellular biology/anatomical sciences, ceramic sciences and engineering, chemistry, civil engineering and technologies, computer engineering/programming/science/information technology, construction engineering, electronics and communications engineering, engineering mechanics/physics/science, general engineering, general science, industrial engineering, manufacturing engineering, materials engineering, mathematics, metallurgical engineering, microbiological sciences/immunology, mining and mineral engineering, nuclear and industrial radiologic technology, nursing, oceanography, petroleum engineering, pharmacology and toxicology, physics, physiology/pathology an related sciences, polymer/plastics engineering, quantitative economics, statistics, textile sciences and engineering
