HOW DO I REQUISITION SMALL ARMS/ WEAPONS/MOUNTS?

1. Submit 80 column MILSTRIP requisition through the supply system to NAVSUP Weapon Systems Support Mechanicsburg PA, Routing Identifier NRP. One Touch is the method used for weapon ordering for Small Arms. GDSC is NOT authorized to submit requisitions for small arms/weapons.

Access to One Touch can be gained by visiting https://www.onetouch.navy.mil/static_ots/index.html

2. If the request is for a weapon replacement, 5G or 5S advice code, prior approval is required. Email smallarms@navy.mil and copy smallarmsreqs@navy.mil with the serial number and issue causing your weapon to be downed.

If the request is for an initial issue request or for MLSR, no prior approval is required.

When requesting any weapon, submit one requisition for the full quantity where advice code and NSN are the same. One for one requisitions are not required for 6D cog items.

3. Cite the appropriate Advice Code.

Options are:

5A If weapon being replaced was a surveyed item, MLSR

5D If weapons are initial issue

5G If weapons to be replaced have already been returned to Crane. This option requires prior approval by the Registry, smallarmsreqs@navy.mil

5S All weapons should remain in place until permission has been provided for a full replacement by smallarms@navy.mil and copy smallarmsreqs@navy.mil

The Navy Small Arms Weapons Registry must have a copy of the report of survey (DD200) before a replacement will be shipped.

****Note: This will allow you to use the packing/containers in which you receive your replacement weapons to return the unserviceable weapons to Crane.**

HOW DO I ESTABLISH OR CHANGE AN ALLOWANCE FOR SMALL ARMS/WEAPONS?

1. Determine your needs.
Note: Allowances for SURFOR ships, air craft carriers and submarines are established on class allowances. For questions regarding these allowances, please contact your TYCOM.

National Stock Number (NSN)
Present and revised allowance quantity totals
Brief justification for your allowance change
Unit Identification Code (UIC)

5. You will be notified of approval or disapproval. If approved, you will be issued an updated Small Arms Allowance List.

WHERE AND HOW DO I RETURN SMALL ARMS/WEAPONS?

1. No weapon will be returned for replacement without prior authorization from the Small Arms Help Desk, smallarms@navy.mil. Weapons should be held as remain in place, until your authorized weapon replacement has been received. This requires the use of a 5S advice code.
2. As soon as small arms or weapons are determined to be in excess of your small arms allowance, all activities will return them to Crane.
3. Ship your small arms or weapons to UIC N00164:

Ship the items in accordance with Physical Security Regulations mandated by the Controlled Inventory Item Code (CIIC).

4. At the time of shipment, forward a legible copy of your DD1149 shipping document and a serial number listing to the Small Arms Weapons Registry and Allowance Branch by email to cran_annual@navy.mil, or FAX to 812-854-1221 DSN 482.
5. The shipping document should include the following information and should be placed in the first box when multiple boxes are used:
 - a. Qty / NSN / Nomenclature / Serial numbers
 - b. Document number: Your UIC / current Julian date / four-digit serial number*
 - c. Ship-from address and UIC
 - d. For remarks: "Turn in of weapons" and "Certified clear of ammunition"
 - e. Point of contact for your activity, including name, phone number and email address
 - f. Utilize TAC NS5X for return weapon shipments.**

* If you are returning excess, you may use a document number of your choosing. However, if you are returning unserviceable small arms because replacements were received, you must use the same document number as you used to requisition the new weapons.

6. When possible, turn your weapons in to a FLC or DLA facility for shipment to NSWC Crane, IN. **TAC NS5X must be used for returning weapons on DD1149.** TAC NS5X is not applicable to use for returning mounts.
7. Include Weapons Log Books and any barrels that was provided as initial outfitting for all small arms EXCEPT the M203 Grenade Launcher. For M203 grenade launchers, if you are replacing

unserviceable you need to keep all of the equipment that came with the M203 for use with your replacement weapon.

8. Weapons should be cleaned, tagged and wrapped.
9. Weapons shipments should be coordinated with the local Installation Transportation Office (ITO). The ITO will ship this material according to the items Security Risk Code (SRC) and or the Controlled Inventory Item Code (CIIC) in conjunction with the Defense Transportation Regulation (DTR) 4500.9-R-Part II and any other policies and procedures that apply. If an ITO is not available, refer to the DTR for proper shipping guidance. The information in the following paragraphs is general in nature.
10. Per the DTR "Small arms are SRC II and SRC IV weapons and include rifles that do not fire a round greater than .50 caliber and shotguns of any gauge."
11. CONUS shipments to NSWC Crane of Small Arms in quantities of 15 or less can be shipped via FEDEX and UPS with Next-day delivery and signature service. USPS Registered Parcel Post is also an authorized option. Both methods of shipment must conform to the carrier's size and weight requirements. Requisitions of more than 15 small arms cannot be split to utilize this shipping method. Weapons must be packed in cardboard containers appropriate to the weight of the shipment. There are to be no markings on the outside of the container to indicate weapons are enclosed. All paperwork is to be placed inside the container. Shipping label only on the outside. Please refer to the DTR Chapter 205 for more information on utilizing these methods of shipment. Services will be determined by the security risk code and priority of the weapons to be shipped.
12. CONUS shipments to NSWC Crane of more than 15 small arms, other weapons and weapons parts should be shipped according to the SRC or CIIC utilizing commercial carriers providing Transportation Protective Services (TPS) as specified by the DTR. The local ITO will schedule a carrier and ensure proper TPS requirements and National Agency Checks required by the DTR are met. Shipments utilizing a Bill of Lading should be annotated "CARRIER DISPATCHERS MUST CONTACT 812-854-5538/3333 24 HOURS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL."
13. ALL OCONUS to CONUS shipments should be shipped via the local ITO. Shipments generally will require movement via military air or Registered Parcel Post.
14. CIIC 2 materials require advanced shipment planning with NSWC Crane prior to shipping. Shipper can contact cran_dla_receiving@navy.mil or call PHONE 812-854-1582 OR 812-854-6902 to coordinate inbound shipments.
15. Weapons shipments must be marked for BLDG 2522. Shippers and carriers should utilize the Transportation Facilities Guide DODAAC: SV3151 to research NSWC Crane Weapons receiving information.
16. Reports of Shipment (REPSHIPS) are required for all CIIC/SRC weapons shipments. More

information on preparing a REPSHIP can be found in the DTR Chapter 205 paragraph L. REPSHIP's can be emailed to cran_dla_receiving@navy.mil or faxed 812-854-3841.

HOW TO REPORT SMALL ARMS RECEIPT/TURN-IN

1. If you are shipping weapons, at the time of shipment you must forward a legible copy of your DD1348 shipping document listing serial numbers to the Small Arms Weapons Registry and Allowance Branch by email to cran_annual@navy.mil, FAX 812-854-1221 DSN 482, or mail to:

2. If you are receiving weapons, you must forward a legible, signed copy of the DD1348 shipping document with a serial number listing. The serial number listing must display each serial number under the proper Nomenclature and National Stock Number (NSN). Documents may be faxed, emailed or mailed to the addresses listed above.
3. NOTE: Due to the sensitive nature and the security risk category of small arms, you must ensure that every degree of caution is taken to report small arms. At the first indication of non-receipt of a shipment of small arms, be familiar with the reporting requirements of the report of shipment (REPSHIP). If shipment is not received within 48 hours of ETA, notify NSWC Crane, Small Arms Inventory Manager, Ms. Dee Haywood at 812-854-1780 DSN 482 or email teresa.haywood@navy.mil.

The 48-hour reporting required for Cat II weapons is covered as an OPREP3 Navy Blue report in OPNAVINST 3100.6G.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR NAVAIR WEAPONS

1. If your allowance establishment/change request includes NAVAIR weapons from the following list, you must address NAVAIR on your request.

FACTS ABOUT SMALL ARMS AND ORGANIZATIONAL MATENANCE

As a result of various fleet activities calling to discuss their inability or lack of authority to requisition and replace parts on small arms and small arms mounts, the following clarification is provided.

All Navy activities holding an allowance for small arms are authorized to perform organizational level maintenance. This is in addition to normal preventive maintenance covered by maintenance requirement cards. The guiding document for determining if lost or failed parts can be requisitioned and replaced at the organizational level is the allowance parts list (APL) for the weapon.

The APL contains an entry called the source maintenance and recoverability code. A typical code would be PAOZZ. The "PA" is the source code and is always the first two letters. "PA" means the part is stocked and issued by the regular stock system and is obtained by a funded requisition. The third entry in the example, "O", is the maintenance code. The "O" means the part can be removed, requisitioned and replaced at the organizational level. An O or 2 - 6 in this position means that organizational level maintenance can requisition and replace the part. An entry of "H" is applicable to NSW only and normally has a Note assigned on the upper left corner of the APL stating "SM&R CODE PAHZZ PARTS ARE FOR NSW UNITS ONLY. The fourth and fifth entries in the example, "ZZ", means the part is not repairable and is a consumable item. For complete description of codes see NAVSUPINST 4423.14b.

Parts coded with a "PA" source code and an organizational level maintenance code can be requisitioned through the regular stock system. Costs for the parts are paid by the requisitioning activity. Weapons which have missing or defective parts, not coded for organizational level maintenance, must be replaced by requisitioning replacement weapons from NAVSUP Weapon Systems Support (NAVSUP WSS) Mechanicsburg PA.

It is the user activity's responsibility to ensure that accurate and current configuration data is reported to the Navy's weapon system file and reflected in their COSAL. Configuration changes should be reported to the ship/activity's configuration data manager (CDM) via an OPNAV 4790/CK form.








Figure 8-1. Repair Parts for Daisy 853 (Cont'd)
