Tuition Ordering and Payment Process Handbook – Appendix A-9

SUBJECT: System for Award Management (SAM)

PURPOSE: To inform NROTC Unit Ordering Officers of the process for verifying the university is registered in the SAM database and allowed to conduct business with the Government prior to awarding a DD FORM 1155, Order for Supplies or Services, or a modification made on Standard Form 30, Amendment of Solicitation/Modification of Contract that increase the obligation amount.

OVERVIEW: Pursuant to Federal Acquisition Regulations, FAR 4.1103, the Ordering Officer shall verify that the college/university is registered in the SAM database before awarding a DD Form 1155 or issuing a SF 30 that increases the obligation amount.

Ordering Officers will verify and document in the contract file the university's responses to Certification Regarding Responsible matters and Representation by Corporations Regarding Tax Delinquency per FAR 9.104-5(a) and 9.104-5(b). The university's affirmative representations of tax delinquency or non-responsibleness will prohibit an award. Ordering Officers will immediately notify their chain of command for any affirmative representation and contact the ESA Program Manager for further guidance.

This policy requires Ordering Officers to conduct SAM verification checks two-weeks before to term start date and within 24-hours prior to signing the DD Form 1155 or a contract modification SF 30, which will increase the contract cost.

When any of these verifications indicate the university's registration is expired, soon to expire or not properly registered, the Ordering Officer shall work with the university to re-register.

NROTC Unit Ordering Officers are **PROHIBITED** from placing an order with, or issuing a modification that increases contract cost to any university that does not have a valid and cleared SAM listing.

Due to the Government Accountability Office Report Number GAO-19243 determined that due to regulatory and system changes, <u>the Summary page previously used no</u> <u>longer meets requirements.</u>

ACTION REQUIRED: NROTC unit Ordering officers shall follow the procedures in this policy to properly verify a University's eligibility to be awarded tuition task orders or modifications with an increase in funding amount.

1. Navigate to <u>www.sam.gov</u>. You will have to register for an account using your .mil email address.

2. Click on "Search Records."

- 3. Type the colleges/university's CAGE code in the appropriate field, and click "Search."
- 4. Locate the correct contractor record.
- 5. Verify that the university is eligible to receive government funds:
 - (1) Registered for "All Awards"
 - (2) Active account not expiring before award,
 - (3) No exclusions,
 - (4) No delinquent federal debt,
 - (5) Determination of Responsibility.

6. Each completed SAM verification must be printed and filed in the contract file. Each SAM printout will contain at a minimum the sections identifies in this appendix.

NOTE: SAM verification SHALL be completed within 24-hours prior to placing <u>EVERY</u> DD Form 1155 and <u>EVERY</u> SF 30 that increases the dollar amount of the order.

REGISTERING FOR A SAM'S ACCOUNT

Go to www.sam.gov and select "Sign In".

Accept the terms and conditions.

Select "Create an Account"

Enter your <u>MILITARY EMAIL ADDRESS</u>. Select "Select your email language preference", check "I have read and accept the Login.gov Rules of Use". Enter "Submit". Using an .edu email address will limit/prevent your ability to utilize certain required functions in the system.

The system will send an email for you to confirm the email address. Follow the e-mails guidance.

Create your password and select "Continue"

Select your "Authentication method setup". You have the option of using your CAC login or if you wish to login using your email and password, you have a choice of "Text or voice message" or "Backup codes". USING ANY METHOD BESIDES CAC WILL REQUIRE YOU TO ACCESS THE SYSTEM EVERY 90-DAYS TO KEEP ACCOUNT ACTIVE.

For text option, enter your phone number, select "Text message" and "Send Code".

Enter one-time code and select "Submit". Codes expire within 10-minutes of issuance.

Select "Agree and continue".

Read the terms of services and select the "I agree" box. Select next.

Enter your profile information. In the "Sub-Tier" block, enter "Navy" and select "1700 – DEPT OF THE NAVY". Select "Submit".

Select "Skip and Finish"

Select "I agree to the SAM.gov User Access Terms" and select "Submit".

VERIFICATION OF SAM's REGISTRATION

SAM.gov has several avenues to search for an entities CAGE code and printing of the report. This policy will only cover one of those avenues.

Go to <u>www.sam.gov</u> and login. Select "Home" located on top left of the screen or clickon Uncle Sam's hat. From the home screen, look for "Already know what you want to find." Select the "Domain" drop down and select "Entity Information". Enter the CAGE code of your university that is listed in the ESA and select the magnifying glass. **YOU ARE PROHIBITED TO USE ANY OTHER CAGE OTHER THAN THE ONE LISTED IN THE ESA OR UNLESS CHANGED BY A MODIFICATION ISSUED BY FLC.**
