

## Army Diver Program

Alpha Company 169th Engineer Battalion trains four Army Engineer diving courses



Engineer Diver, MOS 00B10 (CIN A-433-0024) is 130 training days. It teaches entry-level diving skills as well as army specific tasks like underwater mine and counter mine operations, underwater demolitions and engineer reconnaissance



Engineer Diver Basic Non-Commissioned Officer Course (CIN A-433-0068) is a 70-day course of instruction. Staff Sergeants receive the training given to become First Class Divers. Additionally, the soldiers receive engineer specific training focusing on operations planning.



Army Master Diver Course (CIN A-433-0064) is the pinnacle of Army dive training. Successful completion of this 20-day course results in the award of the Master Diver Badge. The course includes classroom testing and training and a rigorous 3-day performance evaluation.



Marine Engineer Diving Officer, (CIN A-4N-0024 / A-4N-0042) is a joint course of 130 training days (97 training days for non-Army). It teaches entry-level diving skills, army specific tasks such as underwater mine and counter mine operations, underwater demolitions, engineer reconnaissance as well as advanced diving physics, medicine and supervisory skills to prepare junior officers for entry into the Army, Navy, or Coast Guard diving communities.
