2.0	.29	Upon completion of this unit of instruction, the student will achieve and maintain a level of physical conditioning and proficiency that will enable satisfactory performance of rescue swimmer duties on land, in a swimming pool, or open ocean, while wearing appropriate Rescue Swimmer equipment as outlined in NWP 3-50.1 and OPNAVINST 3130.6 series, without injury to personnel or damage to equipment.
3.0	.55	Upon completion of this unit of instruction, the student will demonstrate proper rescue techniques of military and civilian personnel, day or night, utilizing appropriate SAR equipment for at-sea and overland rescues as outlined in NWP 3-50.1 and OPNAVINST 3130.6 series, without injury to personnel or damage to equipment.
4.0	.15	Upon completion of this unit of instruction, the student will identify and treat medical emergencies using approved SAR medical equipment, as per NAVEDTRA 14295 and NWP 3-50.1 manuals, without injury to personnel or damage to equipment.
