1. The following changes should be made to reference (a):

a. Professional Core Competency Objectives, page viii, add the following paragraph:

O. Know the basic information found in Naval Tactical Publications (NTP), Naval Warfare Publications (NWP) and Allied Tactical Publications (ATP) systems.

b. List of Instructional Aids, page x, paragraph I.A.1:

(1) Move "The Gallant Breed: Marine in Combat, 60 minutes" to be paragraph I.C.4 on page xi.

(2) Change paragraph I.A.2 to be I.A.1.

c. Bibliography, page xvi, paragraph A.2: Change "CNO's Guidance for 2005" bibliography entry to read:

Chief of Naval Operations, "The Navy Strategic Communications Guide: Playbook 2006" (Available at: <http://www.nomi.med.navy.mil/conference/documents/CNO%20Communication%20Plan%20Playbook2006.pdf>.)

d. Bibliography, page xvii, paragraph B.1, below the A. M. Knight reference, add the following:

e. Laboratory 3, page 40, add the following on the line under "TITLE: RADIOTELEPHONE EXERCISES":

LEARNING OBJECTIVE: Know the basic information found in Allied Tactical Publications (ATP) systems.

f. Laboratory 4, page 61, add the following on the line under "TITLE: TACTICAL MANEUVERING EXERCISE":

LEARNING OBJECTIVE: Know the basic information found in Allied Tactical Publications (ATP) systems.

g. Lesson 18:

(1) Page 120, paragraph I, add:

G. The student will know the basic information found in Naval Tactical Publications (NTP) and Naval Warfare Publications (NWP) systems.

(2) Page 123, add:

L. Discuss the use of and type of information found in the NTP.

M. Discuss the use of and type of information found in the NWP.

h. Lessons 18-28, paragraph II.A. Add the following as the last instructor reference: "Strategy and Tactics". Number the new paragraph accordingly.

i. Lessons 19-25 and 28, "Instructor references" and "Student texts" paragraphs. Change the "CNO's Guidance for 2005" entry to read:

j. Table of Contents, page i: Add "Record of Changes" as page ii and change remaining page numbers on list accordingly.

k. Insert enclosure (1) after page i and change current page numbers **ii-xxi** to be **iii-xxii**.
